2.	Tej patta (Bengali)	<i>Cinnamomum tamala</i> (Buch.-Ham.) T.Nees & C.H.Eberm.	Leaves used as spice.	
3.	Darchini(Bengali) Dalchini(Hindi)	<i>Cinnamomum verum</i> J.Presl	Bark used as spice.	

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4.	Curry patta(Bengali)	<i>Murraya koenigii</i> (L.) Sprengel	Leaves used as flavoring of vegetables.	
5.	Choti Elaychi(Bengali)	<i>Elettaria cardamomum</i> (L.)Maton	Dried fruit used as spice and also cultivated in agricultural lands.
